HOPMAN CUP JAN

GETTING AROUND

BUS

Transperth bus services arrive and depart regularly from Perth Busport and Elizabeth Quay Bus Station, and stop throughout the city.

A Free Transit Zone (FTZ) operates within the City of Perth boundary (excluding Crawley and Nedlands).

To travel free, you must start and finish your journey within the zone.

If you start and finish within the zone, you can ride the bus without buying a ticket. If your journey starts or finishes outside the zone, you must pay a fare for the whole journey.

TRAIN

Perth CBD has three stations: Perth Station, Perth Underground Station and the Elizabeth Quay Station. Purchase a Smartrider card or ticket from any station to ride. For more information, visit any Transperth information office or call 136 213.

FERRY

Services depart daily from Elizabeth Quay Jetty (Perth) and Mends St Jetty (South Perth/Perth Zoo).

TAXI

Designated taxi ranks are located around the central city. Perth's major taxi companies include:

AIRPORT

TO AND FROM T1/T2 PRECINCT

Bus Route 380, fittingly named after the Airbus A380, has dedicated luggage racks and runs daily between the Elizabeth Quay Bus Station and T1 and T2.

TO AND FROM T3/T4 PRECINCT

Bus Route 40 operates 7 days a week between Elizabeth Quay Bus Station and T3/T4.

Alternatively, you can catch a taxi, ride share service or shuttle bus.
